Canberra Grammar School, an Anglican day and boarding school, established in 1929 is situated in Red Hill, a beautiful suburb, ten minutes from the heart of the city.

There are two Boarding Houses accommodating boys from Year 7 to Year 12. Senior boys have single rooms whilst younger boys share. Each House has computer areas (with email and internet access availability), and a library.

All boys enjoy access to a Common Room with kitchen, billiard table, and a television.

There are tennis and squash courts, an indoor swimming pool, music practice rooms, various ovals, and cricket nets, and on weekends boys can play basketball and table tennis in the first-class Health and Physical Education Centre.

Resident staff, together with students' individual tutors, ensure that boys are cared for, and are provided with, an environment where they can study effectively and achieve their potential. The School offers HSC credentials in which our boys achieve extremely well.

The bush capital offers extensive educational and cultural opportunities, and access to beautiful open spaces and recreational areas.
