Warrina Hostel, under the auspices of Aboriginal Hostels Limited, is situated on the outskirts of the town of Dubbo, approx 420 km north-west of Sydney.

One of the larger AHL hostels, and in a beautiful bush-land setting, Warrina caters for up to 36 indigenous boys and girls who attend either Delroy High School or Dubbo High School.

Accommodation is in dormitory blocks containing single and shared rooms with shared facilities. The kitchen, dining-room, lounge/TV, and the main Office are located in a separate building.

A House-parent couple are responsible for the pastoral care of the students, assisted by a Supervisor, a Recreation Officer, and catering staff who provide the meals.

Extensive grounds surround the hostel, providing ample space for recreational facilities including courts and a swimming pool. As the hostel is some distance from the town, buses are provided by AHL for transport to sporting and social events.
