Woolaning Homeland Christian College is located on the north-western corner of Litchfield National Park, about 2 hours drive south-west from Darwin. The students are drawn from the Cox/Finiss and Daly River regions in the Northern Territory.

Many of the secondary aged students have English as a second language, and the College education program has a heavy emphasis on literacy and numeracy in a Christian context. The senior program provides students with the ability and confidence to move from the College into the outside world.

The school year is divided into six terms, with each term being of six weeks duration. This helps students be regular attendees at school, as their time away from home is reduced to a shorter period. The student's families are active in supporting the College to ensure that their children are attending school.

Accommodation is in 4 family group homes, 2 each for boys and girls, with 12 students in each house being cared for by a "Dad and Mum".
