Abergowrie College is a Catholic Boys' Secondary College situated in the Herbert River valley, west of Ingham in North Queensland. Beginning in 1933 as St Teresa's Agricultural College, for over seventy years now the College has provided the opportunity for boys to receive a Catholic education with all that this implies.

The College has undertaken to play a significant role in the formation of the young men who are boarders. The current enrolment is 240 boys who come from centres all around Queensland, Northern Territory, and Western Australia as well as Papua New Guinea and other overseas countries. Boarders are encouraged to be active, involved, and to make the most of the educational opportunity presented to them. Emphasis is placed on activities, tasks and experience that give rise to a "full" life.

The College provides a unique rural environment which is relaxed and free from city pressures. This allows all boys to participate in a quality Catholic education blended into a safe, secure and relaxed lifestyle.

Abergowrie offers 24 hour care, supervision and recreational opportunities along with standard schooling. Weekend and after school activities are numerous and include: abseiling, fishing, camping, trips to movies and football games. All team sports are catered for and students engage in inter-house & school sports across the year.
