Burra Student Boarding Facility (Goyder House) is situated in the mining town of Burra some 160 km north east of Adelaide.

The hostel was established in 1990 in what was previously the nurses home in the grounds of the Burra Hospital. The 2-storey facility caters for up to 15 students, with girls' accommodation upstairs and boys' downstairs. The kitchen, dining room and TV/Lounge are situated on the ground floor.

The majority of the students are from isolated pastoral areas in the north-eastern section of South Australia. The students, in Years 8-12, attend the Burra High School.

A live-in Supervisor is responsible for both the pastoral care of the students and the day-to-day running of the hostel, including preparation of meals.

Burra is a member of the South Australian Rural Student Accommodation Program funded by the South Australian Government.
