Cleve Student Hostel is situated in the rural town of Cleve, in central Eyre Peninsula, approx 500 km by road from Adelaide. The hostel was established in 1991 to enable isolated children to access the agricultural courses offered by the Cleve Area School.

With a capacity of 8 students, this co-educational 'family friendly' home is attended by House-Parents who provide all meals, washing and supervision for the full seven days or five days.

Accommodation is available in single rooms with study facilities, and bathrooms shared with one other student. A common lounge and computer room is available to all.

The school offers a three-year Certificate in Agriculture course which provides practical skills learned on the 400 hectare farm, Sims farm.

Cleve is a member of the South Australian Rural Student Accommodation Program funded by the South Australian Government.
