Wiltja Residential Program is a part of the Anangu Education Services situated on 2 hectares in Northgate, a suburb of Adelaide.

Up to 60 indigenous students residing at Wiltja come from the remote Anangu Pitjantjatjara/Yankunytjatjara Lands of north-western South Australia and bordering into WA & NT. The students attend The Wiltja School which is a separately staffed secondary program situated in Woodville High School assisting them to manage the transition into the mainstream academic program at Woodville from Yr 8 to Yr 12.

Twelve fulltime Youth-workers and three fulltime Recreation Co-ordinators provide care and a comprehensive recreation and social learning programs designed specifically to provide experiences to enhance cross-cultural learning.

The Program develops the skills, abilities and confidence in social, living and health areas for these young students to reach their intellectual, academic and social potential enabling them to gain greater self management within their communities as they become adults.

The program includes coached sport and physical education, music, arts, a radio studio, heated swimming pool, courts and other facilities.
