Worawa Aboriginal College, located in Healseville approx 50 km east of Melbourne, is Victoria's only Independent Aboriginal school.

An Aboriginal Community initiative, the College commenced operation in 1983 to provide an education for Aboriginal students with emphasis on cultural values, academic achievement, and the development of practical skills important to everyday life and employment.

Worawa is a unique educational institution in that it provides main-stream education in a culturally supportive environment, which delivers to its students a level of self-esteem and confidence. As a residential school, the College has the opportunity to spread the educational message over 7 days a week each term in an interwoven package.

Focus is given to a holistic program that develops the social, physical, intellectual, emotional and spiritual well-being of each student, offering them the opportunity to become a contributing member of a just and civil society.
