Catholic Agricultural College Bindoon is a Year 7 to 12; co-educational secondary college for day and residential students situated in the picturesque Chittering Valley, an hour's drive north of Perth. The College is a Catholic school built on a tradition inspired by their founder Blessed Edmund Rice, and aims to provide an education based on Christian values that respects the dignity of each individual and encourages the growth of initiative, responsibility, leadership and involvement.

It is set on a large working farm, with cattle and sheep livestock, wheat and other crops, an olive grove, a state of the art trade-training centre and one of the best equine facilities in the State.

Through its qualified team of teaching staff, its partnerships with TAFE and its links to the Apprenticentre, the College is able to provide a broad range of educational courses enabling students to attain their Certificate of Education, plus complete nationally recognised certificate courses in Agriculture, Rural Operations, Wool Handling, Automotive, Hospitality, Engineering, Equine Industry and Horse Breeding. The range of education and training available allows successful students to readily progress into further studies, apprenticeships or the workforce.

Brand new boarding facilities have just been completed for our female boarding students, who are accommodated in three boarding houses. Male boarding students are accommodated in separate dormitories to the girls. A large kitchen and dining room caters for communal meals.



A variety of recreation and sporting activities is offered, including pony club and cattle club together with swimming pool, ovals and courts for sport.

Students come from rural and remote regions throughout WA as well as the Perth metropolitan area.
