Clontarf College Boarding House is located on the Stirling Highway at North Fremantle south of Perth. The hostel is situated in the premises formerly occupied by people on bail from Court and has been in operation since 2000.

Clontarf is a community that works primarily to assist young Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Australians to access opportunities for spiritual, educational, physical, cultural and social renewal that will enhance their future lives.

Accommodation consists of double rooms with bunks, bathroom facilities, and a large dining room and kitchen. A recreation room provides for sport and recreation, and students are regularly taken on excursions by the supervisors.

The Boarding House, catering for boys in Years 10, 11 and 12, is an extension of the College, and the Pastoral Care of the students is the Management's chief concern. The values and rules that are a part of the College also apply in the Boarding House.
