Cunderdin Agricultural College, established in 1959, is located 3 km north of the town of Cunderdin, which is approx 170 km east of Perth.

The college was given its present title in 1984 when it separated from the town school. Now a co-educational facility with a capacity of 112 students, it is situated on 2,114 hectares of land.

The farm is used for cropping, animal production and land conservation. The extensive land-care program attempts to combat and manage the salt affected land.

All students are in Years 11-12 and are accommodated in 3 major dormitory blocks which contain twin-share rooms and facilities. Meals are served in a large dining complex, and an impressive recreation centre caters for the leisure needs of the students.

Cunderdin Agricultural College is a campus of the Western Australian College of Agriculture.
