We are looking for Christians with a heart for mission among Indigenous young people. There are opportunities to work and live with these teenagers in the Top End. Our College provides a secondary education for Indigenous young people from remote communities and elsewhere.

Family Group Home

Staff and students live in community in Woolaning. Students live in Family Group Homes with full time House Parents who teach them to take on significant responsibilities as members of a family group.

There is an opportunity to work and live with these teenagers in the Top End as Store Keepers. The Store Keepers are employed to run the College Store especially in support of House Parents in the running of the Family Group Homes at the College and to provide a service to the local community. The Store Keepers also book and arrange accommodation on site for builders, guest staff and other visitors, clean guest quarters and launder linen used. If time permits they may also support the College by cleaning vehicles and buildings and supporting the maintenance team.

Life at Woolaning is unique. The College is situated in a remote location 75km west of Batchelor on the boundary of Litchfield National Park. The College is placed there deliberately to provide a secure educational opportunity with minimal distractions. Most students come to secondary schooling with limited educational background; for many, English is their third or fourth language.
