Do Not interfere with, damage or destroy software & computer systems	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Loss of Equipment use privilege.• Referral to the Manager for further consequences.
Do Not interfere with cords or cables or move equipment	
Do Not , change move or destroy any files on any machine	

The above acts will be construed as vandalism and will be severely dealt with. Students may find that they may be withdrawn from total computer use and parents billed for any time fixing or replacing the equipment. Additionally, students are advised;

Follow all Supervisors instructions & requests	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Loss of computer privilege for day
Do Not move computers, peripherals or unplug the power to systems	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Loss of computer privilege for balance of week• immediate referral to manager for further consequences
Do Not touch any other students work or files.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Loss of computer usage for one week
Do Not make, view or distribute inappropriate material.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Loss of equipment privilege for four weeks.• Immediate referral to manager for further consequences
Do Not eat or drink in the computer area.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Food stuffs confiscated• Banned from area for one week• Immediate referral to manager for further consequences
Do Not use Internet during study times without special permission each time, or after school without permission each time.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Loss of equipment privilege for one week.• Immediate referral to manager for further consequences
Treat College equipment, books, and resources with care.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Loss of equipment privilege for one week.• Immediate referral to manager for further consequences.• Charged for cost of replacement
