

Swanleigh Mobile Phone Policy

The use of mobile phones is common in our society today and becoming increasingly common in our residential college. While mobile phones give students more flexibility of contact and security while they are away from Swanleigh, students must realise that having a mobile phone at Swanleigh is a privilege.

The following are rules, which apply to the use of mobile phones at Swanleigh:

- All students at Swanleigh are permitted to have mobile phones with the permission of their parents.
- Mobile phones are only to be used at times when other phones are available, as listed in the student handbook.
- The year 11 students may use their phones up to 9:30pm
- Year 12 students may use their phones up to 10:00 pm
- Mobile phones are not to be used in the dining room, at church, during meetings, or during prep.
- The phones are the sole responsibility of the individual student ie loss lending or billing.
- The students must give the mobile phone number and other relevant information to their house parents

It is recommended that the mobile phone be kept in a secure place when it is not in use.

Inappropriate use of any mobile phone or use at restricted times may result in the phone being confiscated for at least one week.

Specific requests regarding the use of mobile phones outside the nominated hours should be discussed directly with the Head of Boarding.
