Each student should have the right to a satisfactory level of privacy and ‘personal space’ for study, sleeping and ablution needs.

In the residential setting it is difficult to achieve each student’s right to privacy because of the closeness of the living quarters. Students should be made to feel that their room or dormitory is their own personal area in which they may feel safe and secure. Visitors generally should not be allowed into bedrooms or dormitories. A parent may visit a student’s room or dormitory only with the permission of the duty supervisor and the other residents.

Supervisors should consider students’ privacy when monitoring the dormitories and living areas but be mindful of maintaining a presence in these areas.
