

## Uniform Dress

### Clayfield

#### Dress Code

- Dress standards must be non-offensive
- Normal rules apply to the wearing of jewellery and make-up
- Footwear – closed in shoes must be worn.
- Tops/Blouses/Shirts – must be a suitable length to have no midriff showing and must have sleeves. Slogans, Logos, etc. must be in fitting with the image of Clayfield College
- Shorts – must be long shorts  $\frac{3}{4}$  length to knee length. No slashed or frayed shorts or jeans.
- Skirts/Dresses – must be of a suitable length to maximise sitting comfortably and not cause offence
- PE Classes – if you have a PE Class or sport training on a free dress day, you must change into regulation uniform

#### Dance Rules and Dress Code

Students should have regard for self-respect when considering dress.

#### The 5 No's.

1. mini skirts
2. midriff, strapless or backless tops
3. masseur sandals or thongs
4. slashed or frayed jeans or shorts
5. unsavoury slogans on clothing or body
