Uniforms

School uniforms are purchased at the beginning of each year.

Each student receives 2 sets of uniforms and 4 pairs of socks.

Joggers and school bag are also supplied at the beginning of the year.

It is the student's responsibility to keep their uniforms in a neat and tidy condition, free of graffiti and paint.

If a school uniform is damaged in anyway by the student, they will be asked to pay for a new set.

Uniforms must be removed each afternoon as soon as they return from school and placed into the laundry baskets.

Uniforms are washed by the staff and students can collect a clean uniform each morning.

The Trinity Bay State High School Policy must be adhered to ie: no excessive jewellery, neat and tidy at all times, no double or triple garments to be used under uniform, making it look untidy and unruly.
